What’s there?



- * A basic dashboard (called the “Homeroom”) with specialized “widgets”
- * A collection of over 3,000 units, lessons, prompts, assessments, videos, and web links
- * Right now, most content is in K-9 math, science, ELD, literacy, soc studies, counseling
- * More content areas adding all the time
- * E-collaboration around all instructional materials

How are the instructional materials organized?



- * All anchored in BSD Learning Targets
- * Ability to filter By Subject, Grade, and Learning Target
- * Or by Units, Lessons, Prompts, Assessments, and other types
- * Search function disaggregates results by type

Can I contribute to TeacherSource?



- * Absolutely! This is the heart of TeacherSource.
- * Start with the Create button and choose what you want to contribute.
- * Contribute proven lessons, prompts, assessments, and support links.

Where do I go if I need help?



- * There’s online help within TeacherSource - particularly in the Create menu
- * Contact a TeacherSource “Scout” within your building (or region)
- * Or view the HELP Tutorials on the BSD TeacherSource page
- * Need further help? Go to Open Labs, ask Scouts, sign or up for an online class.
