

World Languages Curriculum Learning Targets Level 2

Culture

- Recognize and demonstrate basic polite behaviors and nonverbal cues in limited situations as related to level one and two topics.
- Identify and locate target language countries and their capital cities.
- Able to explain a limited number of common events of miscommunication between speakers of English and the target language and explain what caused the misunderstanding.
- Recognize common first and last names.
- Understand and explain differences between register.

Listening / Watching

- Demonstrate comprehension of messages from authentic and other sources for a variety of purposes.
- Comprehend familiar ideas and details in short sentences, paragraphs, and simple questions of level one and two topics.
- Comprehend main ideas and some supporting details from simple narratives.

Speaking / Signing

- Describe and talk about information and ideas using level one and two topics.
- Participate in conversations using sentences, everyday expressions, and memorized phrases.
- Identify familiar objects.
- Pronounce words clearly enough to be understood by a sympathetic listener.
- Able to ask answer questions.

Reading

- Demonstrate comprehension of information read from a variety of printed texts and videos, which include authentic sources.
- Read words, signs, phrases, sentences, and simple paragraphs on level one and two topics.
- Read and comprehend target language conventions.
- Comprehend main ideas supporting details from simple narratives and authentic materials.

Writing / Composing

- Write short phrases, lists, sentences, and paragraphs.
- Write using the alphabet, spelling, accents, and punctuation.
- Compose notes, letters, short essays, and poems using level one and two topics for a variety of audiences and purposes.
