

INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES
SPECIAL EDUCATION
TWO HOUR DELAYED OPENING
2011-2012

A decision to open school two hours late is made on the basis of analysis of actual and projected weather conditions in all areas within the Beaverton School District (BSD) boundaries. The major objective in making this decision is to ensure the safety of all BSD students as well as parents and BSD employees.

If the Beaverton School District is opening school **two hours late, bus service will not be provided to programs outside the Beaverton School District** boundaries, except for those schools/programs located within approximately three (3) radius miles from BSD (greater area). Transportation will be provided two hours late for the following schools outside boundaries but inside the greater BSD area if the school is open:

SCHOOLS/PROGRAMS INSIDE GREATER BSD AREA (Bus service is provided for “two-hours late” when these schools are open).

- ◆ LIFEWORKS NW (TIGARD)
- ◆ GRONER

SCHOOLS/PROGRAMS OUTSIDE GREATER BSD AREA (Bus service cannot be provided on a “two-hour delay” even if these schools are open—See Transportation Option 1 or 2).

- ◆ LIFEWORKS NW (PORTLAND) (NICKERSON DAY TREATMENT)
- ◆ OREGON STATE SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF
- ◆ EDGEFIELD AT PARK ROSE KNOTTS
- ◆ PARRY CENTER (PORTLAND)
- ◆ TUALATIN EARLY INTERVENTION
- ◆ SERENDIPITY (PORTLAND)
- ◆ GATELY (PORTLAND)
- ◆ THE PARK ACADEMY
- ◆ HILLSBORO EARLY INTERVENTION

TRANSPORTATION OPTION 1 AND OPTION 2

For the schools/programs located outside the greater BSD area that will not receive bus service when there is a two-hour delay, THERE ARE TWO OPTIONS FOR TRANSPORTATION WHEN THE SCHOOL IS OPEN:

OPTION 1): You may elect to transport the child yourself and receive reimbursement from the BSD Transportation Department for mileage (at the district rate) to and from the program/school.

OPTION 2): You may choose instead to contact **Radio Cab** (503-205-3311) and request that they transport your child. You need to ask for a district-approved driver. Radio Cab is the only company with arrangements to transport Beaverton students. BSD will reimburse the parent for the cab fare when presented with a cash receipt. A cash receipt can be obtained from the driver.

SCHOOLS/PROGRAMS WITHIN . BOUNDARIES AFFECTED BY TWO-HOUR

DELAYED OPENING (For schools/programs located within the BSD boundaries, there will also be schedule changes. Please see list below).

- ◆ **Woodside Early Intervention (EI) classes/services** will be cancelled for the morning. Bus service will be provided for the 11:00 a.m. or later sessions.
- ◆ **Shelter Students living outside of the BSD boundaries** will not receive bus service when there is a two-hour delayed opening. Parents of students attending these schools may use Transportation Option 1 or Option 2 described above.
- ◆ **Deer Park Academy** morning session will be cancelled.
- ◆ **Cascade Academy** students will be bused two hours late.
- ◆ **Levi Anderson** students will be bused two hours late.
- ◆ **Pacific Academy** students will be bused two hours late.
- ◆ **The following Head Start Programs will be bused 2 hours late: Kinnaman, Elmonica, Chehalem, and Beaverton Child Development Center.**
- ◆ **Health and Science (Capitol Center)** students will be bused two hours late. However, if student's normal class begins at 11:00 or later, they will receive transportation services on time.
- ◆ All other In-district Special Education programs will be bused two hours late.
- ◆ All Special Ed AM kindergarten classes will be cancelled.
