Community

Beaverton, a suburban residential area,
is located eight miles west of Portland.
The Beaverton School District serves
an extended community of over
240,000 people, many of whom work
as professionals in the metropolitan
area. Westview High School is located
in an area of rapid growth in
technology-related businesses such as
Intel and athletic/outdoor businesses
such as Nike and Columbia
Sportswear.

School Organization

Westview offers four, 85 minute classes each day. All classes meet every other day on an odd/even block schedule. Full-time students are enrolled in seven classes each semester. Each student completes his or her schedule with a study hall period. Students in study hall engage in personal study, enrichment opportunities, academic or social interventions, or a variety of other school-wide activities. Westview utilizes a semester calendar, each semester lasting 18 weeks.

Westview High School has both a weighted GPA and Rank in Class as well as an unweighted GPA and Rank in Class noted on the transcript. Advanced Placement and other college-level courses appear in bold on the transcript and are weighted. Grades of A, B, or C earn weighted credit of one additional grade point. Class Rank is determined by the accumulative semester GPA from 9th grade through the most recent semester grading period. Total class enrollment is used in computing the class rank.

Graduation Requirements Class of 2012

Westview graduates are required to earn a minimum of 24 credits (0.5 credits for each semester course successfully passed), during grades 9 through 12. Courses required for graduation are as follows:
