The Project Team’s work will begin in September, 2017 and will conclude by June, 2018. The team will meet one weekday evening per month from 4:30 – 6:30 p.m.

The ELL Curriculum Adoption Project Team will review existing ELL curriculum and practices in order to make curriculum and adoption recommendations to the School Board. The Project Team and supporting cadres will be charged with:

- Researching and recommending a theoretical foundation for language acquisition to be used across ELL programs
- Researching best practices and instructional materials to be considered for possible adoption across ELL programs
- Recommending professional development and structures for ongoing professional learning

- **Students:** Name, address, school and grade level, and any special training or experience in the ELL program.
- **Parents/Community Members:** Name, address, ages of children and schools where enrolled (if applicable), and any special training or experience in ELL or second language learning.
- **Teachers:** Name, address, teaching experience, and current assignment.
