## **Deadline extended to apply for Science Project Team**

The Beaverton School District has extended the deadline for administrators, teachers, parents, and community members to apply to serve on the Beaverton School District's Science Project Team. The Project Team's work will begin in **September, 2018** and will conclude by **June, 2019**. The team will meet one weekday evening per month from 4:30 – 6:30 p.m.

The Science Project Team will review existing Science curriculum and practices in order to make curriculum and adoption recommendations to the School Board. The Project Team and supporting cadres will be charged with:

- Researching best practices and instructional materials to be considered for possible adoption in Science
- Articulating long term and supporting learning targets and assessments in Science
- Recommending professional development and structures for ongoing professional learning

The Beaverton School District reviews and updates its curriculum, instructional practices, and classroom materials according to Board policy and Oregon State Statute and Administrative Regulations.
