EMERGENCY CLOSURES

Delayed Opening of School

On occasion, weather or other conditions may permit school to operate but require that the opening of school be delayed.

When the above conditions exist, the opening of school and the schedules of buses will be delayed two hours. Staff members are to report two hours later than their regular reporting time (except for designated staff). The buses will operate two hours later than their normal schedule. When inclement weather is the cause of a delayed opening, this schedule will be known as the "snow day" schedule.

Local radio stations will be informed of the delayed opening or "snow day" schedules prior to 6 a.m.

School Closure Due to Inclement Weather

When schools are closed due to inclement weather, only selected custodial and maintenance personnel are required to report for duty. The supervisor of custodial and maintenance services will determine and inform those persons who must report for work.

Other school employees are not required to work unless notified by their supervisor.

Local radio and TV stations will be informed of weather closure prior to 6 a.m.

Early Dismissal of School

On occasion, weather or other conditions such as a bomb threat or power outage may require that school be dismissed early. When conditions exist, the dismissal of schools and the schedules of buses will be changed to two hours earlier. The buses will operate two hours earlier than their normal schedule.

Local radio and TV stations will be informed of the early dismissal at least 90 minutes prior to the early dismissal of the first school. The decision by the district to dismiss early must be made at least two hours prior to the early dismissal of the first school.

Except for designated employees, all employees will be dismissed according to the same revised schedule.
