

## **Title IA/Parental and Family Involvement**

The district recognizes that parent and family involvement is vital to achieve maximum educational growth for students participating in the district's Title IA program.

The superintendent shall ensure equivalence among schools in teachers, administration and other staff, and in the provisions of curriculum materials and instructional supplies.

Therefore, in compliance with federal law and Oregon Department of Education (ODE) guidelines, the district shall ensure that parents are provided information, in an annual school-based meeting, regarding their school's participation in the Title IA program and its requirements. Parents and family of participating students shall be informed of their right to be involved in the development of their school's Title IA plan and school-parent compacts.

The superintendent shall develop administrative regulations to implement this policy and meet the requirements of the law.
