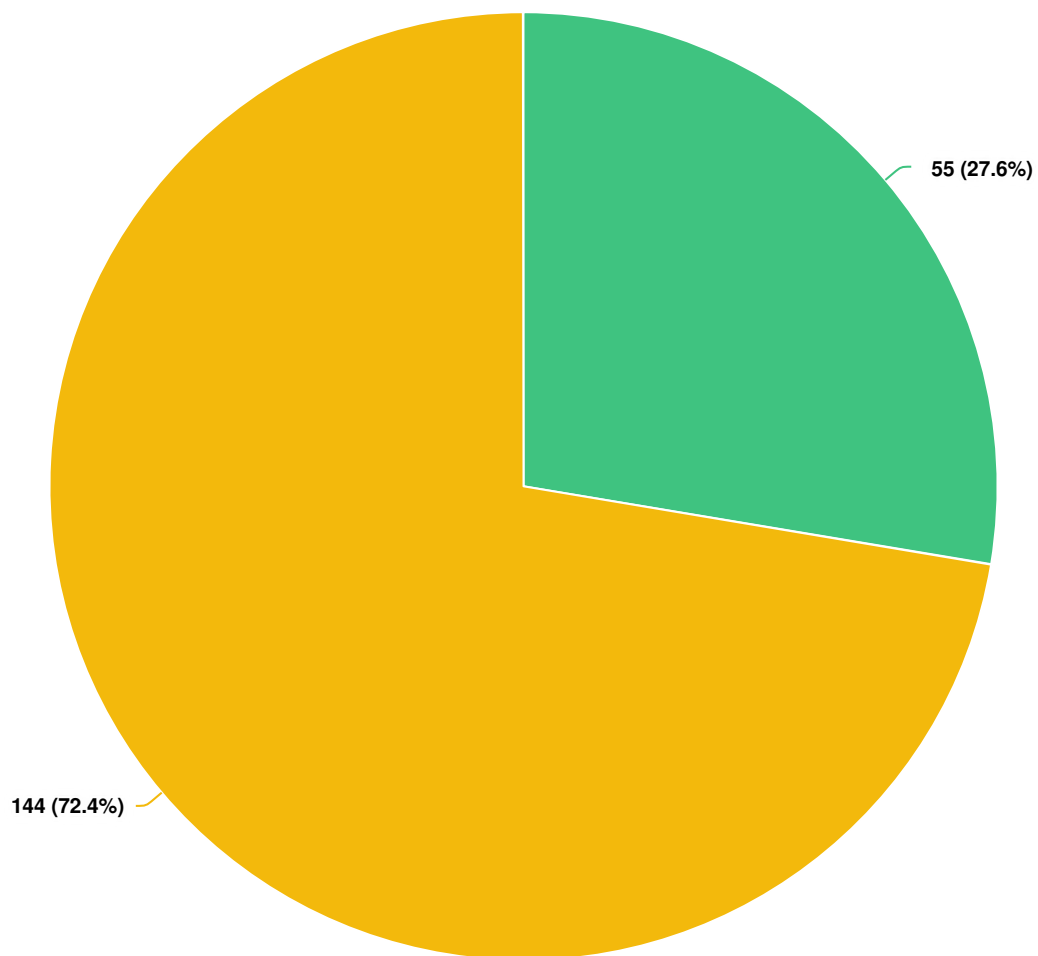

My elementary school experience at BSD was fantastic, I had fantastic teachers ([REDACTED]). However, the middle school and high school experiences were some of the most destructive ever. I went to Summa at Stoller and the environment in such a program was extremely toxic and almost encouraged students in the program to develop a condescending attitude towards those not in the program. Not because of anything teachers or staff did, but rather because of things they didn't do. In addition, the Summa program as a whole takes students that, quite often in my experience, think they are "better" than others in some way due to their intelligence, and puts all of them in classes together with little to no experience socializing with students outside of the Summa program outside of electives. Even in those electives, I often saw Summa students socializing with each other rather than others. I firmly believe that the Summa program simply should not exist. Instead, you should place into a higher math class, or place into a higher science class, etc. Grouping students that place higher in all core classes together for three years during a time period where immaturity is so, so very prevalent, and social views are still being developed and instilled in students, is an absolutely awful idea and my opinion on that will never change. In addition, BSD has throughout the years show a complete and utter lack of care for the mental health of students. Yes, you have your legally obligated talks about how much you care and education about things you can do to help cope with depression, anxiety, or anything else, but outside of those obligations, you are absolutely AWFUL at helping students with ANY mental health issues. The only help you do provide is legally obligated, things like 504 plans, and you don't even TELL STUDENTS ABOUT HOW TO ACCESS WHAT MINIMAL HELP YOU DO OFFER. I didn't even know 504 plans were

a thing until learning about them in my intro to education class at PCC. I've struggled so much with depression, testing anxiety, struggling to find friends, my brother literally hanging himself, and the only thing I ever got was a counselor going "we're here for you," and a figurative pat on the back. When my brother hanged himself I had a teacher say "wow, that's really [REDACTED], take it easy for a week," and then after that week act like nothing happened. Another teacher said "hey don't worry about late work for a bit, take some time to process things," and then after two weeks, not great but somehow twice as great as [REDACTED] was, acted like nothing really happened. I had ONE teacher who actually showed support for me as a student. Not a counselor, a teacher with no obligation to do so. Apparently the counselors didn't have such an obligation either though. Also, you turn a blind eye to academic bullying. If it isn't physical or no physical threats are involved, you act like nothing is happening. Even if it is physical, it seems like you don't care. I have a friend at westview who was literally pulled to the ground and beat up while someone recorded, and the teacher said "don't worry, I won't mark you late." One of their friends who was witnessing it threw something at the attackers, trying to defend her friend, and SHE got a suspension (to my knowledge). That is utterly absurd. How can you as a district claim you care about the mental health and safety of students when something like that can happen? No matter how much you say you do, I will absolutely never believe that BSD actually cares about students until you do something that shows that you do. Actions speak louder than words, and your actions are announcing how little you care for the entire world to hear. Do better.

One thing that I've wanted to have for the entirety of my student life in the BSD is a stronger, more overt empathy for the Black community, as well as a bigger Black population in the district. While I do realize that this isn't exactly something that can be controlled on such a large scale, it is discouraging to feel the isolation of being quite literally one of two Black people in my entire class. I don't feel represented at all. Not in my class, not in the body of people teaching me. Of all my years being in the Beaverton School District--since 1st grade--I have never once had a single Black teacher. The staff I meet that are POC and in the Black community are janitors and bus drivers, and even there, we are few. I don't know if this is a coincidence or if I just happen to be living in the epicenter of some drastic phenomena where I am the only example I see of what success can be within my demographic, but whatever the cause of this insane lack of Black leaders and teachers that can tell me how to go through grade school successfully, it doesn't change the fact that it's disheartening. The

second thing is school meals and the timeframe surrounding them. A significant portion of my time is spent at school--roughly eight hours on average, 455 minutes exactly, 20 of those minutes being passing time and exactly half an hour for lunch. At ISB, if you pass through the main doors at 7:30 AM, you are considered late for class, which means that sometimes, I leave the house without eating breakfast so I arrive at school on time. The cafeteria does serve breakfast and lunch, but we are teenagers that play sports, have a high metabolism, and need a lot of blood sugar to get through one day of shoving facts and information into our heads at a collegial level at 16 years old. Food, especially good food, can change animosity into joy. The food I have been forced to survive on for both breakfast and lunch has not only left me feeling hungry ten minutes after the meal, but half the time it simply doesn't taste like it should be eaten. Therefore, after eating school lunch, I am not only hungry from not having enough to eat because of the limit on food per person and poor portion size, but I am angry at the fact that I'm hungry, I'm tired of being forced to go back to class on an empty stomach, and I'm emotional at the disgusting plate of food that I was forced to swallow down to quench the searing pain in my stomach that has lasted since 6 in the morning when I needed to be boarding the bus. This leads me to my third and final point: The start time at ISB is 7:30 AM. This is at least an hour too early. Why is it that elementary schools start at 8:30 when in the bleak hours of twilight, small children seem to want to do nothing but bounce off the walls? At ISB, at the very least for the students in my family and in the class of 2023, very few people fall asleep before 10 PM, usually, because they are finishing homework. I mentioned in the previous paragraph that the morning school bus arrives at 6 AM. I need roughly an hour to get showered and ready for the day, so my alarm is set for 5 AM. I don't know how anyone has time to go through the hot lunch line. If you keep your lunch in your locker and have to go get it, that takes most of your time. I can't keep my lunch in the locker for that reason, no time. We work hard at school and being hungry all day because we don't get enough time is a real problem. When you're hungry, everything is harder. Many of my friends don't even bother to get food, even though they are hungry, and just sit till they kick us out for pointless "recess" because there's no time to eat it all or get full. So much good food goes in the trash from everyone, and it wouldn't if they had time to eat it. It's also not good to have to rush through and not be able to chew well. I don't like to bring fruit and veggies in my lunch because they take longer to chew. This is teaching kids nutrition isn't important, caring for yourself isn't important. It tells me the school doesn't care about my body, or my health or if me or other kids are hungry. I've tried to get to the cafeteria as quickly as possible but it doesn't matter, I still have less than 10 minutes to eat most days. Every day I don't get to eat much of my lunch because they make us go outside so fast. I'm lucky to have a teacher later in the day that lets me eat in class, otherwise I'd be starving. I shouldn't have to rely on that though. What about the other kids? My mom said that there are many kids who's only meals come from school lunch and they don't get food at home. What about those kids? For myself, it's even more than just being hungry, or rushing. I have chronic stomach issues. Lunch time not only causes stress, which can cause physical stomach pains, rushing to eat just doesn't help my stomach feel any better. Another thing is there isn't enough support for students who are struggling. I'm struggling in summa math because I was somehow supposed to already know 6th grade math even though I was going into 6th grade for the first time. I was in flex last year. Nobody prepared me or my parents and now I am the one suffering. Sometimes my teacher gets annoyed when she's helping me understand things. She gets to a point, where if I

still don't understand a concept, she makes irritated expressions and no longer helps me, or I just stop asking for further explanation. I'm still lost. My parents have talked to the counselor, the summa people, and the teacher and nobody seems to be able to help me fast enough. Some days I can do the work, most days I struggle. I know I'm smart, but I don't feel like it because of this. Passing time is only 4 minutes, barely enough time to get to your next class, which allows no time to go to the bathroom. 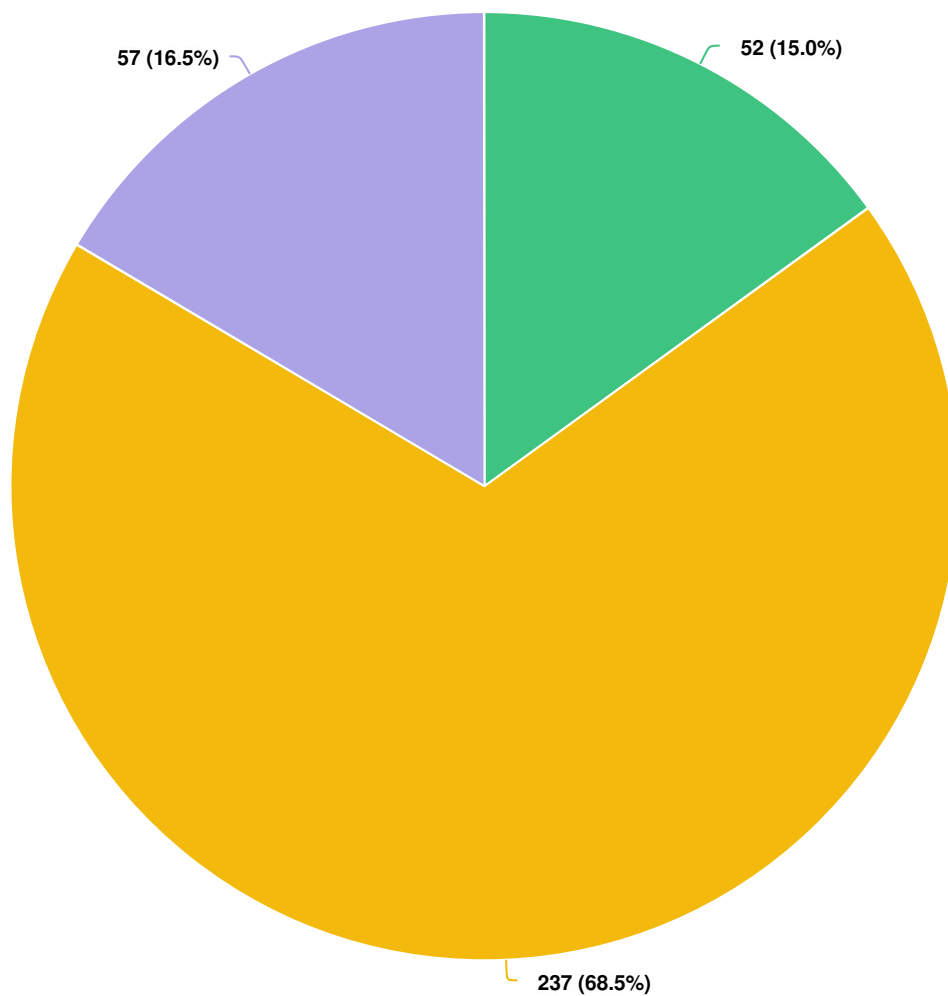
