



IPM POSTING CHANGES

The Beaverton School District will be implementing a change to the notification process of a pesticide application. In the past, the Principal's Secretary or the Head Custodian would post the notification to the front door 24 hours in advance, this is no longer required. The Oregon Department of Agriculture does require that Warning Signs be posted at the application site (ie: baseball field, classroom door, etc.) 24 hours in advance, and to leave the signs up until 72 hours after a pesticide application is applied. See examples below of the New Posting and the Old Posting.
