

Two Ways to Get Recognized!

 Did you know you can earn Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum status for your walk and roll efforts at school? Beaverton Safe Routes to School has developed a Recognition Program for schools so you can have an easy framework for your transportation efforts – and well-earned bragging rights.

For instance, Bronze level includes steps such as identifying a walk and bike coordinator at your school; holding at least one encouragement per year; and collecting information on how students traveled to school for one day. We can help you with each of these steps.

Platinum-level schools develop a Travel Action Plan; carry out a student-led event or activity; and add a SRTS coordinator/committee organizer to your parent/teacher organization.

This might be a whole school, a group or an individual that is making a big difference in their community by promoting and encouraging safe, active travel to and from school.
