#### **CLARIFICATIONS:**

Clarifications and Questions from March 28, 2019 Pre-Bid Conference

Question: Does the Contractor need to move the furniture and other items? Answer: No. The District will move all necessary items before work begins.

Question: The floor is concrete underneath?

Answer: Yes.

Question: Is this room [108] the only room with a partition?

Answer: No. The drawings show all rooms with a partition.

Question: High traffic areas will need a better transition due to the new carpet being thicker than

existing due to wear.

Answer: A low profile rubber or vinyl transition strip may be used where new carpet meets existing

carpet. Please note the site map has been amended to show the transition in the N. Hallway ending at the narrowest point to ensure minimal use of a transition in this high traffic area.

Question: What is the plan for the transition in the doorway? Do we run the new modular carpet and get

out to the other piece of carpet or do we leave a three (3) inch piece in the doorway? Or what

about an aluminum threshold?

Answer: A low profile, non-ferrous, aluminum threshold must be installed at all doorways where new

carpet meets old carpet. Threshold must be mechanically fastened.
