BSD 毕业率

对大多数学生群体而言，Beaverton 学区 2020 级 4 年按时毕业率升至历史最高水平。历史上毕业率较低的学生群体获得了很大的收获，缩小了成绩差距。黑人学生毕业率首次超过白人学生毕业率。

在 2019-20 学年，几乎每个 BSD 学生群体的四年和五年毕业率均高于本州水平。全学区四年按时毕业率从 85.6% 增长到 89.3%。全州率上升到 82.6%。请参阅下表：
