Partnering with you Thank you to all of you who attended Back to School Night. It was great to see you. In my opening remarks, I offered some ways we would appreciate your help as our partner. These expectations are:

- *Encourage strong attendance*
- *Ask students questions about what they are learning and doing: "What did you do to prepare for your future today?"*

***Canvas** is the schoolwide learning system that gives access to class calendars and resources. Parents will have access on their own soon. In the meantime, ask your son/daughter to log on so you can see. This is probably the best way to always check on the classes since you can have a conversation as well.

Future Day Our collective goal at Beaverton High is: *We believe that ALL students will graduate prepared for, confident in, and excited about the futures they choose.* The future each of us chooses is framed by what we do today – actions, decisions, and explorations.
