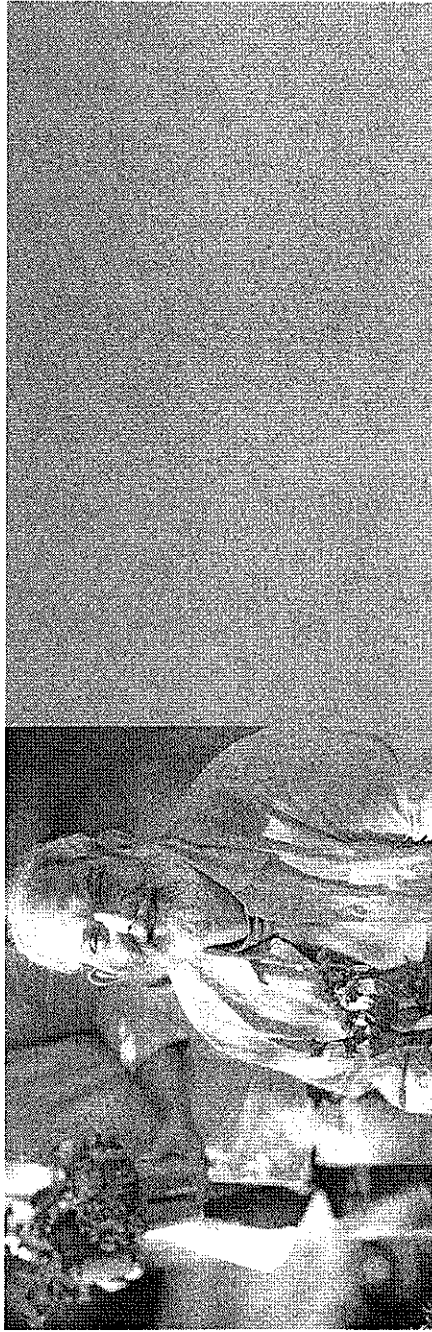

How does it work?

Kaiser Permanente will match staff and physician cash donations greater than \$25 and up to \$100. Grants will be awarded to eligible institutions on a first-come, first-served basis until the annual allocation has been dispersed. Grants are limited to one per individual per year and may not be split among more than one agency.

Eligible Individuals

All regular, full-time Kaiser Permanente employees and physicians are eligible.

Qualifying Organizations

All non-profit 501(c) 3 tax-exempt charitable organizations that provide service in the Denver/Boulder or Colorado Springs areas are eligible to receive a grant.

Ineligible Donations

Donations not eligible for gift matching include those to United Way, Kaiser Permanente's KP Helps Charitable Fund, gifts for religious obligations (tithes), bequests, gifts to non-scholastic programs (e.g., athletics) and gifts that result in a provided product or service.

Ineligible Organizations

Ineligible organizations include political, religious and fraternal organizations, individuals or organizations that pose a conflict of interest to Kaiser Permanente and organizations outside of Kaiser Permanente's service area. The program was not designed, nor does it have the funding, to match pledges solicited by an employee running, walking or biking in fundraising races. Kaiser Permanente will match only the participating employee's gift in a fundraising event consistent with the guidelines described in this policy. Final determination of eligibility will be made by the gift matching coordinator.
