

STOLLER JAGUARS WALKING SAFETY

Each year, as the neighborhoods around Stoller continue to grow, new features like sidewalks are continually being added that make walking to school more convenient. The State of Oregon has generally established that students within 1.5 miles of Stoller are within walking distance. Based upon this 1.5-mile walking distance, Washington County determines the safe walking routes for students.

Because the two busiest roads in our area are Laidlaw and Kaiser, crossing guards have been placed at the following locations where students are to cross to ensure their safety.

Locations:

Bethany and Laidlaw

Kaiser and Wismer

Kaiser and Laidlaw

Skycrest and Laidlaw

Skycrest @ North Entrance to Stoller Middle School

Times:

8:35 am – 9:05 am

3:40 – 4:10 pm.

- If your child lives north of Laidlaw and east of Kaiser, he or she walks either on a local street or along Kaiser to the nearest local street into Stoller. This route does not require a crossing guard.
- If your child lives north of Laidlaw and west of Kaiser, he or she walks south to either Bethany Blvd. or Kaiser Road to cross with a guard at Laidlaw and then heads East to Stoller.
- If your child lives south of Laidlaw and west of Kaiser, he or she walks north either to Bethany Blvd. or Kaiser to cross with a guard at Laidlaw then heads east to Stoller.
- If your child lives south of Laidlaw and east of Kaiser, he or she walks north to Laidlaw to cross with a guard and then heads east to Stoller.
